5 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle
6 Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the
7 movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

TOW-AWAY LANE MUST TURN RIGHT, EXCEPT MUNI - ESTABLISH

Lincoln Way, south side, from 19th Avenue to a point 100 feet westerly.

ONE-WAY STREET - ESTABLISH

Vandewater Street, westbound, between Mason and Powell Streets.

BICYCLE LANES - ESTABLISH

Fell Street, from Scott Street to Baker Street.

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.




