RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:


**NO TURN ON RED - ESTABLISH**

14th Street, eastbound, at Folsom Street [so that an advanced stop line for bikes ("bike box") can be established].

**MULTIPLE LEFT TURN LANES - RESCIND**  
**LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT - ESTABLISH**

Howard Street, westbound, approaching 11th Street

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.




