FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively


1 accept and expend continued funding for this project from the State Office of Emergency

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to  
11 supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors, thus the position vacated  
12 through this program will be backfilled contemporaneously with the same level of local funding  
13 by transferring an equal sum from the Police Department's uniform salary account to its  
14 uniform overtime account for that fiscal year.


