WHEREAS, Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center is licensed by the California Department of Health Services as a general acute care hospital, distinct part skilled nursing and rehabilitation center; and,

WHEREAS, During a recent series of retreats with the Executive Staff of Laguna Honda Hospital along with input from the Health Commission and the Director of the Department of Public Health, the mission of Laguna Honda Hospital was amended by eliminating the phrase "long term care" and replacing this phrase with "skilled nursing services;" and,

WHEREAS, This change in the mission statement was designed to accurately reflect how Laguna Honda Hospital is licensed by the California Department of Health Services; and,

WHEREAS, This change, however, ignores the long standing and well accepted practice that Laguna Honda Hospital is also a long term care facility for those San Franciscans most in need; and,

WHEREAS, In addition to the change in the mission, the admissions policy for Laguna Honda Hospital was changed in March 2004 by the Director of the Department of Public Health, and subsequently reversed back to the previous policy on February 17, 2005; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Executive Staff of Laguna Honda Hospital to amend the recently revised mission of LHH to include "long term care" as one of the goals of the hospital; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Director of the Department of Public Health to publicly consult with the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors before it makes any future changes to the mission and the admissions policy of Laguna Honda Hospital.
