3 **Resolutions declaring April 15, 2005 as Working Families Credit Day in the City and**
4 **County of San Francisco and encouraging all working families in San Francisco that**
5 **qualify to take advantage of the federal Earned Income Tax Credit.**

7 WHEREAS, the Working Families Credit will match a portion of residents' federal
8 Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) benefit, for families that earn less than \$36,000 per year
9 and have at least one child; and

10 WHEREAS, the EITC is one of the nation's most successful anti-poverty programs,
11 which benefits working people by: supplementing wages; reducing tax inequity; and
12 stimulating the local economy; and

14 WHEREAS, over 5,000 San Francisco families have applied for the Working Families Credit
15 and EITC this year, and all who are eligible are encouraged to apply before the April 15, 2005
16 deadline; now be it, therefore

17 WHEREAS, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors extends its highest
18 commendation to the Working Families Credit program and hereby declares April 15, 2005 as
19 San Francisco Working Families Credit Day; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors encourages all working families
21 in San Francisco that qualify to take advantage of the Earned Income Tax Credit.
