3 **Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency to accept and expend**
4 **\$266,666 of Low Income Flexible Transportation (LIFT) Funds, for maintenance of the**
5 **Municipal Railway's #108 Line between San Francisco and Treasure Island, excluding**
6 **administrative overhead costs.**

8 WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is the regional
9 transportation planning agency for the San Francisco Bay Area; and

10 WHEREAS, MTC has developed a process and criteria to be used in the selection of
11 transportation projects for the Low Income Flexible Transportation (LIFT) Program; and,

12 WHEREAS, In collaboration with other public agencies in the Bay Area and MTC's
13 Regional Welfare-to-Work Transportation Working Group, MTC developed a Program of
14 Projects, to be included in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and,

15 WHEREAS, The LIFT Program has been supported with a combination of federal Job
16 Access and Reverse commute, Congestion Mitigation Air Quality, and regional discretionary
17 State Transit Assistance (STA) funds; and

18 WHEREAS, STA program funding is a discretionary resource that can be used for
19 transportation services to increase access to jobs and employment-related services; and

20 WHEREAS, The LIFT Program dedicates funding from flexible STA funds to support
21 the maintenance of the Municipal Railway's (MUNI) #108 Line between San Francisco and
22 Treasure Island; and

23 WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA), City and County of San
24 Francisco, is an eligible claimant for STA capital assistance; and

1 WHEREAS, The grant contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations
2 upon the applicant, including requiring the applicant to provide the eligible share of project
3 costs; and

4 WHEREAS, MUNI plans to secure the eligible share of project costs through local
5 resources; and

6 WHEREAS, On February 1, 2005 the MTA Board of Directors adopted Resolution No.
7 05-020 which authorized the MTA, through its Director of Transportation to accept and expend
8 \$266,666 of Low Income Flexible Transportation Program capital assistance to maintain
9 service levels on the #108 Line between San Francisco and Treasure Island; now, therefore,
10 be it

11 RESOLVED, That the Municipal Transportation Agency, through its Director of
12 Transportation, is authorized to accept and expend \$266,666 of Low Income Flexible
13 Transportation Program capital assistance for maintenance of MUNI's #108 Line between San
14 Francisco and Treasure Island, excluding administrative costs.


