[Three Way stop at Frederick and Willard]

Resolution urging Department of Parking and Traffic to implement a three way stop at Frederick and Willard Streets.

RESOLVED, That, pursuant to the provisions of the California Vehicle Code, the following intersections are hereby designated as "STOP" intersections, and the Department of Parking and Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to cause "STOP" signs to be installed thereat as designated below:

STOP SIGNS - ESTABLISH

Because of increased traffic on Frederick Street due to a street closure, a gymnasium that primarily children attend, and increased events at Kezar Stadium, it is necessary that Frederick Street at Willard be designated as a 3-way STOP.

Frederick Street at Willard, installing 2 STOP signs. One STOP for East bound traffic and one STOP for West bound traffic. With the edition of these two stop signs, this intersection will now be a 3-way STOP.
