12 and fifty-thousand dollars (\$250,000); and


13 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice and the San Francisco Department

18 responsible for programmatic and administrative reporting to BJA; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MOCJ to  
20 retroactively accept and expend \$250,000 from BJA, Office of Justice Programs, to administer  
21 the 2004 Sex Offender Management Discretionary Grant Program.






