3 **Resolution approving the Controller's certification that Airport Employee Parking**
4 **Facilities for San Francisco International Airport can practically be performed by**
5 **private contractor at a lower cost than if work were performed by city employees at**
6 **budgeted levels.**

7 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
8 Proposition J in November 1976, adding Section 10.104.15 to the Charter allowing City
9 Departments to contract with private companies for specific services which can practically be
10 performed for a lower cost than similar work by City and County employees; and

11 WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on July 25,2005 that the services involved in
12 the management and operation of employee parking facilities at San Francisco International
13 Airport can be performed by the contractor at a lower cost to the City and County of San
14 Francisco than if such services were performed by employees of the City and County of San
15 Francisco; now, therefore be it

16 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.104.15 of the Charter, this Board of
17 Supervisors hereby approves said Controller's certification.
