Rudy Corpus, Jr., new appointment, seat 1, must be representative for low-income families who lives with his or her family in SOMA, for a term to be determined by lot.

Conny Ford, new appointment, seat 2, must have expertise in employment development and/or represents labor, for a term to be determined by lot.

Jazzie Collins, new appointment, seat 3, must be a senior or disabled resident of SOMA, for a term to be determined by lot.

Ada Chan (residency requirement waived), new appointment, seat 4, must have affordable housing expertise and familiarity with the SOMA neighborhood, for a term to be determined by lot.

Donald Frazier, new appointment, seat 5, must represent a community-based organization in SOMA, for a term to be determined by lot.

Kelly Wilkinson, new appointment, seat 6, must provide direct services to SOMA families, for a term to be determined by lot.

Steven Sarver, new appointment, seat 7, must have small business expertise and a familiarity with the SOMA neighborhood, for a term to be determined by lot; and, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the SOMA Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory

  Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of

  San Francisco.
- Applicant Ada Chan, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a
  person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the SOMA
  Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory Committee.
- 3. The SOMA Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory Committee has attempted to fill the position, for which Ada Chan was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Ada Chan is qualified to serve on the SOMA Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory Committee.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the SOMA Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory Committee at this time; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Ada Chan, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
