Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to accept retroactively and expend five grants in the total amount of \$11,320 from the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) for the seed, nursery, and sudden oak death programs (\$2,608) and the petroleum products program (\$6,900); and from the California Department of Pesticide Regulation (CDPR) for the pesticide use reporting (\$1,812) program, and to enter into agreements for the use of these funds; for the period of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006.

WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded five small grants in the total amount of \$11,320 from CDFA and CDPR for food and agriculture and pesticide regulation programs; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDFA and CDPR require the City to enter into three agreements (The "Agreements") copies of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>060022</u>, which are hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The grant agreement budget includes provision for indirect costs of approximately \$258.03; and,

WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors because the Department was not forwarded the State Standard Agreements covering these funds until after July 1, 2005; and,

WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually

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considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend three grants in the total amount of \$11,320 from CDFA and CDPR; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreements pursuant to the San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreements on behalf of the City.
