[Assembly Bill AB 2873 - Transportation Development Act Funds.]

Resolution urging the California State Legislature to support Assembly Bill 2873 (Wolk) authorizing local jurisdictions to double the current quarter percent sales tax dedicated to local transit and to maintain local streets and roads in rural counties.

WHEREAS, In 1971 the State of California passed the Transportation Development Act (TDA), allowing the board of supervisors in each county to impose a quarter percent sales tax; and

WHEREAS, Revenue from this fund is returned to county of origin and is dedicated exclusively to provide public transit service, fund bicycle and pedestrian improvements, and to maintain streets and roads in rural counties; and

WHEREAS, The revenue derived from TDA funds serves as the backbone for transit funding throughout California; and.

WHEREAS, TDA funds in the nine-county Bay Area are allocated to local jurisdictions by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency receives approximately \$30 million in TDA funds per year; and

WHEREAS, AB 2873 would authorize local jurisdictions, after approval by the voters and the local board of supervisors, to double the existing quarter percent tax; and,

WHEREAS, This bill would lay the groundwork for the City and County of San Francisco to pursue an additional \$30 million in operating funds for the Municipal Railway, providing a permanent, stable source of revenue; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the California State Legislature to approve Assembly Bill 2873.
