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3 **Resolution determining that the premises to premises exchange transfer of a**
4 **Type 47 (On-Sale General Eating Place) license for a Type 48 (On-Sale General**
5 **Public Premises) alcoholic beverage license from 635 Eighth Street to 430 Mason**
6 **Street to Inner Circle Entertainment IV, LLC dba The Slide will serve the public**
7 **convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San**
8 **Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and**
9 **Professions Code, with conditions.**

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11 WHEREAS, Inner Circle Entertainment IV, LLC is seeking a premises to
12 premises exchange transfer of a Type 47 (On-Sale General Eating Place) license for a
13 Type 48 (On-Sale General Public Premises) alcoholic beverage license from 635 Eighth
14 Street to 430 Mason Street; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
16 zoned; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the alcoholic beverage
18 license application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
20 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
21 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the premises to premises
22 exchange transfer of a Type 47 (On-Sale General Eating Place) license for a Type 48
23 (On-Sale General Public Premises) alcoholic beverage license from 635 Eighth Street
24 to 430 Mason Street for Inner Circle Entertainment IV, LLC dba The Slide, will serve the
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1 public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San
2 Francisco.

3 Conditions: 1) The hours of operation shall not exceed 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.
4 Sunday through Wednesday and 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. on Thursday, Friday and
5 Saturday. The following exceptions(s) shall not constitute a violation of this condition:
6 New Years Eve and five (5) additional days per calendar year may exceed the
7 aforementioned hours and days, subject to the petitioner attaining Department
8 authorization two weeks prior to utilizing said exception. 2) No "happy hour" type of
9 reduced price alcoholic beverage promotion shall be allowed. 3) There shall be no coin
10 operated games or video machines maintained upon the premises at any time. 4)
11 Entertainment provided shall not be audible beyond the area under the control of the
12 licensee(s). 5) No person under the age of twenty-one (21 years of age) shall sell,
13 furnish, or deliver alcoholic beverages. 6) The sale of alcoholic beverages for
14 consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited. 7) Petitioner shall not permit its
15 patrons or the general public to loiter or congregate on the sidewalks adjacent to the
16 licensed premises. The orderly standing of patrons in line to enter the premises shall
17 not be considered loitering or unlawfully congregating. 8) The petitioner(s) shall be
18 responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which
19 they have control. 9) At any time the premises are providing live entertainment, the
20 petitioner(s) shall provide security personnel that shall maintain order therein and
21 prevent any activity which would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of their property by
22 nearby residents. Said personnel shall be clothed in such a manner as to be readily
23 identifiable as security. 10) Petitioner shall not make structural changes in the
24 premises interior without prior written approval from the Department. 11) The interior
25 lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance

1 and conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic
2 beverages are sold, served, delivered or consumed. 12) The exterior of the premises
3 shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily
4 discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises.
5 Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal private and use of
6 any neighboring residences. 13) At no time shall any person under the age of 21 years
7 enter or remain in this public premises.


