4 **Resolution accepting and expending a monetary and in-kind gift valued up to \$500,000**  
5 **from the San Francisco Botanical Garden Society to the Recreation and Park**  
6 **Department for the renovation of the primary pedestrian pathways that run throughout**  
7 **the garden.**

9 WHEREAS, The City maintains and operates real property located on the west edge of  
10 the City of San Francisco known as "Golden Gate Park"; and,

11 WHEREAS, The pedestrian pathways in the Botanical Garden have not been  
12 renovated or improved in many years and are in need of repair; and

13 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Botanical Garden Society commissioned a garden  
14 master planning effort in 1994; and

15 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission approved master plan called for the  
16 renovation and replacement of the pedestrian pathways and circulation routes; and

17 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Botanical Garden Society has raised \$500,000 dollars  
18 to assist in this pathway project; and

19 WHEREAS, The gift will be used for labor and design services for the pathway project  
20 at the garden; and,

21 WHEREAS, The improvement work will be completed to the standards established by  
22 the Recreation and Park Department and governing codes including ADA codes and  
23 regulations; and,




