8 WHEREAS, "Crime Stoppers" is a program by which cash rewards of up to \$2,000 are  
9 offered to anyone furnishing anonymous information that leads to the arrest and charging of  
10 criminals and fugitives; and,

11 WHEREAS, certain neighborhoods and communities within San Francisco have  
12 experienced significant increases in violent crime and homicides, and additional strategies are  
13 needed to provide individuals with opportunities to anonymously come forward to  
14 communicate information regarding the incidents and perpetrators of the offenses, and,

15 WHEREAS, Crime Stopper programs in various jurisdictions throughout the United  
16 States are independent programs, each established through a separate non-profit corporation  
17 and operating under its own bylaws and Board of Directors; and

18 WHEREAS, the First Responder Foundation has established a San Francisco Crime  
19 Stoppers program; and,

20 WHEREAS, A San Francisco Crime Stoppers program may offer a means for the  
21 public to provide information to the Police Department to help solve crimes and to identify and  
22 locate criminals and fugitives within the City; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco supports the efforts of the  
24 First Responder Foundation in its plans to develop and launch a private, nonprofit anonymous  
25 crime information program in San Francisco, and be it
