7 WHEREAS, The Airport utilizes canine (K-9) teams to detect explosives at the Airport;
8 and,

9 WHEREAS, The Airport K-9 Explosives Detection Team Program incurs expenses for
10 handler salaries, handler overtime, handler uniforms (laundry), K-9 food, K-9 veterinary care
11 (medications), K-9 kenneling, vehicles, vehicle care and maintenance, handler training/travel,
12 and explosives training/travel; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Airport will be reimbursed by the TSA of up to \$695,482.60 for Fiscal
14 Year 2005/06 for the Airport K-9 Explosives Detection Team Program expenses incurred at
15 the Airport; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Airport will be reimbursed by the Transportation Security
17 Administration (TSA) of up to \$560,500.00 for Fiscal Year 2004/05 for the Airport K-9
18 Explosives Detection Team Program expenses incurred at the Airport; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Airport will be reimbursed by the Transportation Security
20 Administration (TSA) of up to \$560,500.00 for Fiscal Year 2003/04 for the Airport K-9
21 Explosives Detection Team Program expenses incurred at the Airport; and,

22 WHEREAS, The Airport will be reimbursed by the Transportation Security
23 Administration (TSA) of up to \$240,500.00 for Fiscal Year 2002/03 for the Airport K-9

3 Explosives Detection Team Program expenses incurred at the Airport; and,


4 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; and


12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the inclusion of



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
