Resolution declaring August 18, 2010 as San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council Day in San Francisco.

WHEREAS, Over 1.7 million Americans have been diagnosed with HIV/AIDS since 1981 and more than 580,000 have died; and

WHEREAS, 1.1 million Americans are currently living with HIV/AIDS; and,

WHEREAS, HIV/AIDS infections disproportionately impact gay and bisexual men, especially gay and bisexual men of color, African American women and Transgendered individuals; and

WHEREAS, Nearly 30,000 San Franciscans have diagnosed with AIDS since 1981 nearly 10,000 San Franciscans are currently living with AIDS; and

WHEARES, There are currently more than 20,000 San Franciscans living with HIV/AIDS; and

WHEAREAS, The Ryan White legislation was enacted twenty years ago on August 18th 1990; and

WHEREAS, Community planning through Ryan White Planning Councils was mandated with the enactment of the Ryan White legislation; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council was one of the first planning councils in the nation established under Ryan White legislation; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council has allocated more than half a billion dollars of Ryan White funding since the passage of Ryan White legislation; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council has prioritized services and maintained a system of care for people living with HIV/AIDS in San Francisco that is a model of HIV/AIDS care worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Thousands of San Franciscans with HIV/AIDS have benefitted from the system of care maintained by the work of the San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council in collaboration with the San Francisco Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, Hundreds of community members from San Francisco, Marin and San Mateo counties have served with dedication and passion on the San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council over the past 20 years; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council continues to address the needs of people living with HIV/AIDS in San Francisco, San Mateo and Marin counties with recommendations through prioritization and allocation of Ryan White funds and its collaboration with the San Francisco Department of Health; now

THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors honors and recognizes the work of the San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council and hereby declares August 18, 2010 as San Francisco HIV Health Services Planning Council Day in San Francisco.
