Conditions: (1) Sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, and 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday and on New Year's Eve.

Christmas Eve, Thanksgiving Eve, the Fourth of July, and the Sunday before Labor Day and Memorial Day only. (2) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s) as defined on the ABC-257. (3) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee. (4) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences. (5) Petitioner shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the Department.
