Conditions: (1) The two licenses, type 20 and 42, shall operate in conjunction with one another and shall not be separated. (2) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily. (3) Service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only at the tasting bar as depicted on ABC-257, except for private events that are closed to the public with signage posted. (4) The tasting bar must be sectioned off with "No One Under 21 is Allow" sign clearly posted. (5) Service and consumption of alcoholic beverages must be limited to one (1) ounce pours per serving. (6) The sale of any beer and/or malt product(s) is strictly prohibited. (7) Noise ("noise is defined as any raucous sound that is produced in such a manner or to such a degree as to disturb the peace, quiet, and comfort of persons in the neighborhood") shall not be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee. (8) The petitioner shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (9) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences. (10) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the

licensee. (11) No person under the age of 21 shall serve or deliver alcoholic beverages.
