Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$60,000 from Standing Against Global Exploitation to participate in a program entitled "Cross Bay Collaborative to Combat Human Trafficking" for the period of July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012.

WHEREAS, Standing Against Global Exploitation (SAGE) is the recipient of a grant award from the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Refugee Resettlement supporting The Cross Bay Collaborative to Combat Human Trafficking (CBC); and,

WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, SAGE has subcontracted with DPH in the amount of \$60,000 for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SAGE requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.111038; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The full project period of the grant starts on July 1, 2011 and ends on June 30, 2014, with years two and three subject to availability of funds and satisfactory progress of the project; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to create the infrastructure for a sustainable, community-based anti-trafficking identification and response protocol among and within San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, DPH will subcontract with International Institute of the Bay Area in the total amount of \$14,400; for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for two existing positions, one Health Educator (Job Class 2822) at .20 FTE, one Health Program Coordinator I (Job Class 2589) at .15 FTE, for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$6,217; and,

WHEREAS, DPH is seeking retroactive approval because SAGE did not send the grant award until July 29, 2011; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$60,000 from SAGE; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
