WHEREAS, The 2010-2011 Civil Grand Jury Report entitled "Log Cabin Ranch Moving" Towards Positive Horizons" is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 110815, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and WHEREAS, The Civil Grand Jury has requested that the Board of Supervisors respond to Finding Nos. 5 and 6 as well as Recommendation Nos. 5 and 6 contained in the subject

WHEREAS, Finding No. 5 states: "Due to the age of the buildings (circa, 1950), structural improvements to the Ranch are greatly needed;" and,
