WHEREAS, In 2011, WritersCorps celebrates its 17th anniversary teaching creative writing to more than 700 San Francisco at-risk youth each year by placing professional writers in community settings including public schools, detention facilities, libraries and after-school programs; and

WHEREAS, WritersCorps is considered one of the most effective youth arts programs in the nation, as was evidenced by being selected as one of 15 organizations across the country to receive the 2010 President's Committee on the Arts and Humanities' National Arts and Humanities Youth Program Award, the highest national honor bestowed on youth development programs in the United States, and

WHEREAS, WritersCorps staff and students were invited to the White House twice last fiscal year, first to receive the award from First Lady Michelle Obama in a special ceremony, and subsequently to participate in a national poetry workshop and performance event; and

WHEREAS, WritersCorps publications have received the New York Public Library's Best of Teen Books award and was featured in the New York Times Review of Books; and

WHEREAS, WritersCorps has received this grant award from the National Endowment for the Arts to help support the Corps of teaching artists; and
