

1 [Contract between the Department of Public Health and the San Francisco Community Health  
2 Authority to Provide Provider Payment Services for the Healthy San Francisco Program -  
\$30,940,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Director of Public Health and the Director of**  
4 **the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser to contract with the San Francisco**  
5 **Community Health Authority to provide Provider Payment services for the Healthy San**  
6 **Francisco Program in an amount not to exceed \$30,940,000 for a term of July 1, 2012,**  
7 **through June 30, 2014.**

9 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health desires to provide payments to non-  
10 Department health care providers in the Healthy San Francisco provider network; and

11 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health contracts with the San Francisco  
12 Community Health Authority to provide such payments; and

13 WHEREAS, the amount of said contract exceeds ten million dollars (\$10,000,000); and

14 WHEREAS, Section SEC. 9.118.B of the San Francisco Charter requires that such  
15 contracts be approved by the Board of Supervisors; and

16 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health has previously entered into a contract  
17 with the San Francisco Community Health Authority to perform this service; and

18 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health is satisfied with the performance of the  
19 San Francisco Community Health Authority in the provision of these services; and

20 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Community Health Authority Board operates in  
21 accordance with the Joint Powers Agreement approved by the Board of Supervisors through  
22 Resolution 237-05; now, therefore; be it

23 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Public  
24 Health and the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser, on behalf of the  
25 City and County of San Francisco, to retroactively contract with the San Francisco Community

1 Health Authority (commonly referred to as the San Francisco Health Plan) for an amount of  
2 \$30,940,000 to provide Provider Payment Services under the Healthy San Francisco program  
3 for the term of July 1, 2012 though June 30, 2014; a copy of the contract to be placed in the  
4 Clerk's file, and be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health submit a report to the  
6 Budget and Finance Committee of the Board of Supervisors on the impact of the Affordable  
7 Care Act on the Healthy San Francisco Program participation prior to December 31, 2013;  
8 and be it


9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director




