WHEREAS, The grant does not include any provision for indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department is seeking retroactive approval because it did not receive the grant award until December 6, 2012; and

WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Police Department is authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant from the California Emergency Management Agency in the amount of \$200,000; and be it
