Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$300,000 from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to participate in a program entitled Hepatitis B Early Identification and Linkage to Care for Foreign-Born Persons with Hepatitis B in San Francisco for the period of September 30, 2013, through September 29, 2014.

WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has agreed to fund Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$300,000 for the period of September 30, 2013, through September 29, 2014; and

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDC requires the City to enter into an agreement (Agreement), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.131070; which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to test at least 3,000 foreign-born individuals to ensure that they know their hepatitis B status and link to care anyone who tests positive for hepatitis B infection; and

WHEREAS, DPH will subcontract with Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc. Community Initiatives; and Asian Week Foundation, in the total amount of \$264,124; for the period of September 30, 2013 through, September 29, 2014; and

WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for two existing positions, one Manager I (Job Class No. 0922) at .15 FTE and one Senior Administrative Analyst (Job Class No. 1823) at .05 FTE for the period of September 30, 2013 through, September 29, 2014; and

WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$5,402; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$300,000 from CDC; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract agreement in the amount of \$264,124 with Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc; Community Initiatives; and Asian Week Foundation for services under the grant entitled Hepatitis B Early Identification and Linkage to Care for Foreign-Born Persons with Hepatitis B in San Francisco; for the period of September 30, 2013 through, September 29, 2014; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City.
