Unanimous Vote by MTA Board to Adopt Supervisor Kim’s Proposed Reform of Towing Fees

MTA’s \$65.4M contract with tow company must be revised to consider hardship

San Francisco, CA – “I’m enormously gratified that the MTA Board stood up and recognized that in a city with some of the worst income inequality in the nation, too many families in San Francisco find themselves one missed rent payment away from eviction and displacement. These fines were potentially ruinous for too many. We are working with Debt-Free SF to continue to review the City’s municipal fines overall to ensure that we do not have what amounts to a highly regressive tax system that funds basic services with punitive fines,” stated Supervisor Kim.

Proposal will now return to the Board of Supervisors for a vote next Tuesday, March 22.
