The goal of the District 4 Youth Council is to create opportunities for youth to share their ideas on how to address issues facing their community, the Sunset District, and the City. ## **Qualifications**

- Students at the middle school, high school, and undergraduate college levels
- Must live or go to school within District 4

## Requirements

In order to receive full credit for serving as a member of the District 4 Youth Council, all members must complete the following within one year upon acceptance to the Council:

- Attend at least 6 Youth Council meetings
  - Youth Council meetings are expected to take place monthly, with the exception of July, August, and December.
- Attend/volunteer at minimum of 4 community meetings or events in the Sunset District
  - For a list of meetings and events, please be sure to read Supervisor Tang's monthly newsletter.
  - Examples of community meetings: Meetings hosted by Supervisor Tang's office, neighborhood organizations, or by city departments.
  - Examples of community events include: Sunset Community Festival (September), Autumn Moon Festival (September), Front Yard Ambassadors Program (ongoing), parades, Movies in McCoppin (October), Discover Your District events (monthly).
- We also encourage Council members to stay in regular contact with our office to discuss ideas.
- In order for Youth Council members to receive full credit for participation, a letter of recommendation (upon request), and a Board of Supervisors certificate of honor, all of the above requirements must be met.

#### **Term**

• Youth Council members will serve for **one-year terms** (**January through December**), which can be renewed each year.

## **Application Deadlines**

• Applications will be accepted in **October** each year.
