On July 24, 2018, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board of Supervisors") of the City and County of San Francisco (the "City") adopted its "Resolution of Intention to establish City and County of San Francisco Infrastructure and Revitalization Financing District No. 2 (Hoedown Yard, Pier 70) on land within the City and County of San Francisco commonly known as the Hoedown Yard to finance the construction of affordable housing within Pier 70 and Parcel K South; to provide for future annexation; to call a public hearing on September 11, 2018, on the formation of the district and to provide public notice thereof; determining other matters in connection therewith; and affirming the Planning Department's determination, and making findings under the California Environmental Quality Act" ("Resolution of Intention to Establish IRFD"), stating its intention to form the "City and County of San Francisco Infrastructure and Revitalization Financing District No. 2 (Hoedown Yard)" (the "IRFD") pursuant to Government Code Section 53369 *et seq.* (the "IRFD Law"). The City intends to form the IRFD for the purpose of financing certain public improvements (the "Facilities"), as summarized below.


