If the legislation passes, the following fees shall be increased under Fire Code, Sections 113.2, 113.4, 113.5, 113.6, 113.7, 113.8, 113.9, 113.10, 113.12, and 113.21.

- Operational Permit Filing Fees. From \$125 to \$130 for each hour or fraction thereof;
- Plan Review Fees. From \$125 to \$130 per hour or fraction thereof;
- Field Inspection Fees. From \$125 to \$130 per hour or fraction thereof;
- **Pre-Application Plan Review.** From \$375 to \$390 when an applicant wishes to discuss specific design issues or submit preliminary designs for review and comment, when time spent by the Fire Department exceeds two hours, additional fees shall be assessed increasing from \$125 to \$130 per hour or fraction thereof;
- Re-Inspection of Violation Fees. From \$250 to \$260 for re-inspections, if time required for the re-inspection exceeds one hour an additional fee increasing \$125 to \$130 per hour or fraction thereof;
- **High-Rise Inspection Fees.** From \$13 to \$13.50 per 1,000 square feet of gross floor area:
- Referral Fees. From \$125 to \$130 per hour or fraction thereof for the on-site inspections and consultations;
- Overtime Fee. From \$136 to \$143 per hour or fraction thereof;
- Water Flow Request Fee. From \$125 to \$130 upon the request from a person for water flow information;

Beginning with the set of fees for fiscal year 2019-2020, and each fiscal year thereafter, the Controller shall annually adjust the Department's fees as provided to the extent necessary to ensure that over time each departmental fee does not exceed the cost of providing the service for which the City charges the fee.

- Total Valuation from \$50,001 to \$200,000: \$790.82 to \$822.46 for the first \$50,000 or less plus \$5.4309 to \$5.6482 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof, to and including \$200,000;
- Total Valuation from \$200,001 to \$500,000: \$1,605.47 to \$1,669.69 for the first \$200,000 or less plus \$2.5314 to \$2.6327 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof, to and including \$500,000;
- Total Valuation from \$500,001 to \$1,000,000: \$2,364.91 to \$2,459.50 for the first \$500,000 or less plus \$1.6890 to \$1.7573 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof, to and including \$1,000,000;
- Total Valuation from \$1,000,001 to \$5,000,000: \$3,209.73 to \$3,338.12 for the first \$1,000,000 or less plus \$1.2845 to \$1.3360 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof, to and including \$5,000.000;
- Total Valuation from \$5,000,001 or more: \$8,348.04 to \$8,681.96 for the first \$5,000,000 or less plus \$0.6478 to \$0.6737 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof

Evacuation signage beyond thirty minutes will be assessed at an hourly rate, which is increasing from \$125 to \$130 per hour.

The Fire Department Field Inspection fees shall be increased, based on the following formulas:

- Value of \$0 to \$10,000: \$125 to \$130 for one hour;
- Value of \$10,000 to \$50,000: \$250 to \$260 for two hours;
- Value of \$50,000 to \$500,000: \$375 to \$390 for three hours;
- Value of \$500,000 to \$5,000,000: \$625 to \$650 for five hours;
- Value of \$5,000,000 to \$10,000,000: \$1,250 to \$1,300 for ten hours;

- Value of \$25,000,000: \$3,750 to \$3,900 for thirty hours

Notation to the Filed Inspection fees listed above:
