When there have been three or more verified complaints in the prior year regarding the applicant's compliance with the terms of the permit, the applicable core agency listed above is authorized to develop and charge an additional fee to any applicant seeking renewal for their permit. The fee shall be based on additional time and materials spent by City staff enforcing terms of the permit. The proposed legislation would also amend Public Works Code, Section 2.1.1, specifically listing permit categories, notwithstanding the permit fee provisions listed above:

- Curbside Parklet Fee. The permit and license fees for the types of Curbside Shared Space Permits issued pursuant to Administrative Code Chapter 94A and Public Works Code Section 793 et seq. are as follows, with one half of the fees allocated to the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Authority, and one half of the fees allocated to Public Works. The permit and license fees shall be due and payable as provided in Administrative Code, Chapter 94A:
- **Public Parklet Fees**. Permit fee of \$1,000 for the first parking space and \$250 for each additional parking space; annual license fee of \$100 per parking space;
- **Movable Commercial Parklet Fees.** Permit fee of \$2,000 for the first parking space and \$1,000 for each additional parking space; annual license fee of \$1,500 per parking space;
- **Fixed Commercial Parklet Fees.** Permit fee of \$3,000 for the first parking space and \$1,500 for each additional parking space; annual license fee of \$2,000 per parking space
