The proposed district would be known as the Fillmore Community Benefit District (CBD). Following public comment, ballots submitted by the property owners in the proposed Fillmore Community Benefit District (CBD) will be counted by the Department of Elections and the results will be announced by the Board of Supervisors. If the ballot election does not result in a majority protest against formation of the proposed district, the Board of Supervisors may vote to establish the Fillmore Community Benefit District (CBD).
