[Adopting findings related to the conditional use appeal on property located at 501 - 503 Laguna Street.]

Motion adopting findings related to the appeal of the Planning Commission's approval of Conditional Use Application No. 2001.072C (which authorized, subject to certain conditions, the mounting of three panel antennas within a single cylinder on the roof and the installation of a base transceiver station in the basement as part of a wireless telecommunications network) for a two-story residential over commercial mixed use building within the Hayes - Gough Neighborhood Zoning District (NCD) and a 50-X Height and Bulk District, pursuant to Section 720.83 of the Planning Code, on property located at 501 - 503 Laguna Street, northwest corner at Fell Street (Lot 35 in Assessor's Block 0819).

The appellant, Erik Olsen, filed a timely appeal on May 21, 2001, protesting the approval by the Planning Commission of an application for a conditional use authorization (Conditional Use Application No. 2001.072C, approved by Commission Motion No. 16145 on April 19, 2001) to mount, subject to certain conditions imposed by the Planning Commission. a total of three panel antennas within a single cylinder on the roof, and to install a base transceiver station in the basement, as part of Sprint's wireless telecommunications network. at a two-story residential over commercial mixed use building within the Hayes - Gough Neighborhood Zoning District (NCD) and a 50-X Height and Bulk District, pursuant to Section 720.83 of the Planning Code, on property located at 501 – 503 Laguna Street, northwest corner at Fell Street (Lot 35 in Assessor's Block 0819).

The public hearing before the Board of Supervisors on said appeal was scheduled for June 11, 2001. On June 11 the Board continued the public hearing on the appeal to June 25, 2001. On June 25 the Board conducted a duly noticed hearing on the appeal from the

Planning Commission's approval referred to in the previous paragraph. Following the conclusion of the public hearing on June 25, the Board continued its consideration of the appeal to the Board meeting of July 9, 2001. At the July 9 meeting the Board of Supervisors approved the decision of the Planning Commission by its Motion No. 16145, which approved Conditional Use Application No. 2001.072C.

In reviewing the appeal of the approval of the requested conditional use authorization, this Board reviewed and considered the written record before the Board and all of the public comments made in support of and opposed to the appeal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby adopts as its own and incorporates by reference herein, as though fully set forth, the findings made by the Planning Commission in its Motion No. 16145, dated April 19, 2001; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors further took notice that the San Francisco Department of Planning determined that the project was categorically exempt from environmental review as a Class 1 exemption under Title 14 of the California Administrative Code. The Board finds that there have been no substantial project changes, no substantial changes in project circumstances, and no new information of substantial importance that would change the determination of categorical exemption issued by the Planning Department; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors specifically adopts as its own, and incorporates by reference herein as though fully set forth, the findings made by the Planning Commission in its Motion No. 16145, dated April 19, 2001, that the proposed project is in conformity with the General Plan, and is consistent with the Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors, after carefully balancing the

competing public and private interests, approved the decision of the Planning Commission by its Motion No. 16145, dated April 19, 2001, and authorized, subject to the conditions imposed by the Planning Commission, the mounting of a total of three panel antennas within a single cylinder on the roof and the installation of a base transceiver station in the basement, at a two-story residential over commercial mixed use building within the Hayes - Gough Neighborhood Zoning District (NCD) and a 50-X Height and Bulk District, pursuant to Section 720.83 of the Planning Code, on property located at 501 – 503 Laguna Street, northwest corner at Fell Street (Lot 35 in Assessor's Block 0819).
