4 **Commission and interested members of the Board of Supervisors to plan for and**
5 **execute a Youth Recognition Day, to occur in the fall of each year.**

7 WHEREAS, There have been a number of incidents in San Francisco and the entire
8 country that have tarnished the reputation of youth despite the fact that juvenile crimes have
9 dropped dramatically since 1994; and,

10 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Youth Commission has provided exemplary leadership
11 in helping to address this problem; and

12 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors, in conjunction with the
13 Commission on the Status of Women annually hosts a "Woman Making History" ceremony;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, This ceremony recognizes the contributions of eleven women, one
16 selected by each Supervisor; and

17 WHEREAS, This ceremony takes place as a Special Order of the Board of Supervisors
18 so that all San Franciscans may learn about and appreciate these remarkable women; and

19 WHEREAS, This has been an effective way of recognizing key community leaders;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Youth Commission adopted a resolution on March 29,
22 2001 calling for similar recognition for young people; and

23 WHEREAS, This resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
24 No. 010718 , which is hereby declared to be a part of this motion as if set forth fully herein;
