8 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
9 hereby amends Rule 2.28.1 of the Rules of Order of the Board to read as follows:

10 2.28.1. Introduction; referral to committee; committee report. A proposed Charter
11 amendment shall be introduced by a Supervisor at a regular Board meeting held not less than
12 ~~169~~ 168 days prior to the election at which it is to be acted upon by the electors. At that time,
13 the sponsor shall submit complete text. The introduction of a "skeletal" Charter amendment
14 shall not satisfy the requirement of this Rule. Upon introduction, the proposed Charter
15 amendment shall be referred to the appropriate Board committee for public hearing.
