3 **Motion designating the City Operations and Neighborhood Services Committee of the**  
4 **Board of Supervisors as the Committee on Parades.**

6 San Francisco Police Code Section 371 requires the Board of Supervisors to  
7 designate, by motion, an appropriate committee of the Board to act as a "Committee on  
8 Parades" for the purposes set forth in the Police Code. An applicant for a parade permit  
9 under the Police Code may appeal the denial of an application for a parade permit, or the  
10 imposition of conditions on the issuance of a permit, to the Committee on Parades, if such  
11 appeal can be timely made. The Committee shall consider such appeal and may either  
12 concur in the action of the Chief of Police, or overrule such action and order that the permit be  
13 approved. If the Committee orders that a permit be approved, it shall have the authority to  
14 impose only such conditions as are recommended by the Chief of Police. The Board of  
15 Supervisors has not yet designated a Committee on Parades, as required by the Police Code.

16 **MOVED,** That the Board of Supervisors hereby designates the City Operations and  
17 Neighborhood Services Committee of the Board of Supervisors as the Committee on  
18 Parades, as required by Police Code Section 371.
