3 **Motion granting a waiver from the prohibition imposed by Charter section 13.104.5, to**  
4 **permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections with the November 7, 2006**  
5 **election.**

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco City Charter section 13.104.5 prohibits City employees and  
8 officers (other than the Director of Elections, an appointee of the Director of Elections or a  
9 member of the Elections Commission) from performing "any function relating to the conduct of  
10 an election;" and,

11 WHEREAS, Charter section 13.104.5 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, upon the  
12 request of the Elections Commission, to waive this prohibition by motion; and,

13 WHEREAS, On October 4, 2006 the Elections Commission requested that the Board of  
14 Supervisors waive this prohibition to permit City employees to assist the Department of  
15 Elections with the November 7, 2006 election; now, therefore, be it

16 MOVED, The Board of Supervisors waives the prohibition imposed by Charter section  
17 13.104.5, to permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections before, during, and  
18 after the November 7, 2006 election.
