3 **Motion granting a waiver from the prohibition imposed by Charter section 13.104.5, to**  
4 **permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections with the April 8, 2008**  
5 **election.**

6 WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter section 13.104.5 prohibits City employees and  
7 officers (other than the Director of Elections, an appointee of the Director of Elections or a  
8 member of the Elections Commission) from performing "any function relating to the conduct of  
9 an election;" and,

10 WHEREAS, Charter section 13.104.5 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, upon the  
11 request of the Elections Commission, to waive this prohibition by motion; and,

12 WHEREAS, On March 19, 2008, the Elections Commission requested that the Board of  
13 Supervisors waive this prohibition to permit City employees to assist the Department of  
14 Elections with the April 8, 2008 election; now, therefore, be it,

15 MOVED, the Board of Supervisors waives the prohibition imposed by Charter section  
16 13.104.5, to permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections before, during and  
17 after the April 8, 2008 election.
