3 **Motion granting a waiver from the prohibition imposed by Charter section 13.104.5, to**  
4 **permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections with the November 3, 2009**  
5 **special statewide election.**

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter section 13.104.5 prohibits City employees and  
8 officers (other than the Director of Elections, an appointee of the Director of Elections or a  
9 member of the Elections Commission) from performing "any function relating to the conduct of  
10 an election;" and,

11 WHEREAS, Charter section 13.104.5 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, upon the  
12 request of the Elections Commission, to waive this prohibition by motion; and,

13 WHEREAS, On September 16, 2009, the Elections Commission requested that the  
14 Board of Supervisors waive this prohibition to permit City employees to assist the Department  
15 of Elections with the November 3, 2009 election; now, therefore, be it

16 MOVED, the Board of Supervisors waives the prohibition imposed by Charter section  
17 13.104.5, to permit City employees to assist the Department of Elections before, during and  
18 after the November 3, 2009 election.
