

1 [Appointments, Immigrant Rights Commission - Almudena Bernabeu, Haregu Gaime, Bill
2 Hing, Leah Chen Price, and Elahe Enssani]

3 **Motion appointing Almudena Bernabeu, Haregu Gaime (residency requirement waived),**
4 **Bill Hing, Leah Chen Price, and Elahe Enssani, terms ending June 6, 2016, to the**
5 **Immigrant Rights Commission.**

7 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
8 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Immigrant
9 Rights Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 5.201, for the
10 terms specified:

11 Almudena Bernabeu, seat 1, succeeding Vera Haile, deceased, must have a
12 demonstrated knowledge of, and interest in, the health, human service, educational, or
13 employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion
14 of a two-year term ending June 6, 2016.

15 Haregu Gaime (residency requirement waived), seat 2, succeeding herself, term
16 expired, must have a demonstrated knowledge of, and interest in, the health, human service,
17 educational, or employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the
18 unexpired portion of a two-year term ending June 6, 2016.

19 Bill Hing, seat 3, succeeding himself, term expired, must have a demonstrated
20 knowledge of, and interest in, the health, human service, educational, or employment issues
21 that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term
22 ending June 6, 2016.

23 Leah Chen Price, seat 5, succeeding Teresa Chee, resigned, must have a
24 demonstrated knowledge of, and interest in, the health, human service, educational, or
25

1 employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion
2 of a two-year term ending June 6, 2016.

3 Elahe Enssani, seat 9, succeeding herself, term expired, must be an immigrant to the
4 United States who is appointed in accordance with Charter, Section 4.101, and have a
5 demonstrated knowledge of, and interest in, the health, human service, educational, or
6 employment issues that affect immigrants residing in San Francisco, for the unexpired portion
7 of a two-year term ending June 6, 2016.

8 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 9 1. The membership of the Immigrant Rights Commission has a goal to be
10 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 11 2. Applicant Haregu Gaime, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with
12 experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Immigrant Rights
13 Commission.
- 14 3. The Immigrant Rights Commission has attempted to fill the position, for which
15 Haregu Gaime was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who
16 has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so
17 at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Haregu Gaime is qualified to
18 serve on the Immigrant Rights Commission.
- 19 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
20 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the
21 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is
22 willing to serve on the Immigrant Rights Commission at this time; and, be it

23 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
24 for Haregu Gaime, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can
25 be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101, that requires person(s) appointed to boards,

1 commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors
2 to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.


