2 APPROVING THE SUSPENSION OF FARES ON MUNI FROM DECEMBER 31, 1999 AT

3 8:00 P.M. TO NO LATER THAN 6:00 A.M. ON JANUARY 1, 2000; RETROACTIVE TO
4 DECEMBER 1, 1999.

6 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

7 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby finds and declares the following:

8 A. It is in the best interest of the City and County of San Francisco and the safety and
9 welfare of the residents and visitors to the City and County to provide free transportation on
10 New Year's Eve, 2000.

11 B. The City and County intends to cover a portion of any expenses incurred as a result of
12 the suspension of fares on New Years Eve with corporate donations.

13 C. The Public Transportation Commission has recommended a fare suspension on New
14 Years Eve by Resolution No. 99-119, on file with the Clerk of the Board of
15 Supervisors in File No. 992154.

16 D. The Planning Department has determined that this limited, one-time
17 waiver of transit fares is not subject to review under the California Environmental Quality Act
18 (CEQA), under the general rule that CEQA does not apply to projects where it can be seen
19 with certainty that no significant physical environmental impacts would occur.

20 Section 2. The City and County of San Francisco shall not charge passengers of
21 Muni revenue vehicles fares during the period beginning at 8:00 p.m. on December 31, 1999
22 and ending no later than 6:00 a.m. on January 1, 2000.

23 Section 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies any New Year's Eve fare
24 suspension consistent with the terms of this ordinance implemented by the Public
25 Transportation Commission after the passage of this ordinance but prior to the ordinance's
actual effective date.

Section 4. This ordinance is effective retroactive to December 1, 1999.
