8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

9 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section  
10 16.61-5, to read as follows:


11 **SEC. 16.61-5 ACCEPTANCE OF ROLLOVERS.**

12 The Retirement System shall accept eligible rollovers from other tax qualified accounts, as  
13 defined by federal law, as payment for redeposits, shortages, and prior service buy-backs for temporary  
14 service, military service and representative service.

15 The Retirement Board may adopt such rules and forms as may be necessary to implement the  
16 provisions of this section.




