3 **Ordinance making environmental findings and amending the San Francisco Park Code,**  
4 **Article 12, Section 12.12, to increase the fees at Harding Park and Fleming Golf**  
5 **Courses.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Findings.

11 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this  
12 Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public  
13 Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.).

14 Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section  
15 12.12, to read as follows:

16 Sec. 12.12. FEES AT HARDING PARK AND FLEMING GOLF COURSES.

17 (a) Greens Fees. The Recreation and Park Commission (the "Commission") is  
18 hereby authorized to charge greens fees at Harding Park and Fleming Golf Courses  
19 (collectively, the "Golf Courses") in the manner and in conformance with the standards set  
20 forth herein.

21 1. Target Revenues. Greens fees shall be set at such levels to cumulatively  
22 generate an average minimum of \$4,278,000.00 annual revenues in 2002 dollars ("Target  
23 Revenues") at the Golf Courses in the first five fiscal years of operation following reopening of  
24 the Golf Courses after renovation ("Years 1 – 5") (and subject thereafter to annual increases  
25 in the amount of increases in the applicable Consumer Price Index as described in Section

1 12.12(e) below), which amount shall be prorated if the Golf Courses reopen with less than a  
2 full fiscal year remaining in Year 1. In setting greens fees to achieve the Target Revenues, it  
3 shall be assumed that legal residents of the City and County of San Francisco who hold  
4 current and valid cards issued for a fee by the Recreation and Park Department (the  
5 "Department") identifying them as residents of the City ("Residents") shall play at least 65.50%  
6 of rounds at Harding Park Golf Course, ~~which represents historic levels of Resident play~~, and that  
7 no more than an average of 76,560 rounds shall be played each full year at Harding Park Golf  
8 Course during Years 1 – 5 and no more than 64,600 rounds each full year at Fleming Golf  
9 Course during Years 1 – 5.

10 2. Optional Discounts. Greens fees at Harding Park Golf Course may be  
11 discounted for weekday rounds played by either Residents or non-residents, for weekday or  
12 weekend rounds played by Resident junior or senior golfers, and for twilight rounds played by  
13 either Residents or non-residents. The Commission also may establish discounted greens  
14 fees for playing only the back nine holes at Harding Park Golf Course. Greens fees may be  
15 discounted for certain non-residents who live within close geographic proximity to the Golf  
16 Courses or who play with Residents ("~~Bay Area Northern California~~ Residents"). If the  
17 Commission approves a discounted rate for ~~Bay Area Northern California~~ Residents, the  
18 Commission shall set standards defining who shall qualify for such discounted rate and shall  
19 limit the number of rounds at that discounted rate ~~for Bay Area Residents to no more than 5,000~~  
20 ~~annually~~.

21 3. Optional Premium Rates. In exchange for advance reserved tee times, non-  
22 residents may be charged premium rates at Harding Park Golf Course.

23 4. Caps. Regardless of any discounts for certain subcategories of play, the  
24 average cost per round of Resident greens fees at Harding Park Golf Course across any and  
25

1 all subcategories of Resident play (weekday, weekend, senior and junior) fees shall not  
2 exceed \$28 in Year 1. The average cost per round of non-resident greens fees at Harding  
3 Park Golf Course across any and all subcategories of non-resident play (weekday, weekend,  
4 preferred and Bay Area Resident) shall not exceed \$88 in Year 1. The average cost per  
5 round of Resident greens fees at Fleming Golf Course across any and all subcategories of  
6 Resident play (weekday, weekend, senior and junior) shall not exceed \$13 in Year 1. The  
7 average cost per round of non-resident greens fees at Fleming Golf Course across any and all  
8 subcategories of non-resident play (weekday and weekend) shall not exceed \$20 in Year 1.

9 5. Miscellaneous. Applicable weekend greens fee rates shall be charged on  
10 Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays and legal holidays. Applicable weekday rates apply on all  
11 other days. Greens fees per tournament player for playing in tournaments, which are defined  
12 as a block of tee time(s) set aside for any group of 16 or more golfers, shall exceed the  
13 highest greens fee that would be charged to Residents playing on the same day of any  
14 tournament ~~and may be set as high as the greens fees charged to non-residents with advance~~  
15 ~~reservations, if such a rate is set.~~ Discount Resident greens fees shall not apply to tournament  
16 play by Residents. Weekend tournament greens fees shall be greater than greens fees  
17 charged for weekday tournaments.

18 (b) Commission to Select Final Rate Structure; Citizens Advisory Committee. The  
19 Commission shall select a final greens fees structure which meets the parameters set forth in  
20 this Section. The Commission shall appoint a citizens advisory committee consisting of five  
21 (5) members to recommend to the Commission a greens fees structure for the Golf Courses  
22 chosen from one of the models described below or that otherwise meets the criteria set forth  
23 herein. The Commission shall take the committee's recommendation into consideration in  
24 reaching a final decision regarding a fee structure for the Golf Courses.

1 (c) Notwithstanding the foregoing subsections (a) and (b), effective *Fiscal Year 2005-*  
 2 *2006* September 1, 2006, the following fees shall be charged at Harding Golf Course:


21          (f)    Other Fees and Charges. The Commission shall set the following fees charged  
 22          at the Golf Courses: fees for motorized and pull cart usage, tournament fees, charges for  
 23          driving range usage, reservation fees and cancellation fees, at levels comparable to those  
 24          charged at golf courses of similar quality in the greater San Francisco Bay Area.

1 (g) Annual Increases. Upon the first day following the end of Year 1, regardless of  
2 whether Year 1 consisted of a full fiscal year or only a part thereof, and upon the first day of  
3 each fiscal year thereafter, greens fees for Residents at the Golf Courses may, with the  
4 approval of the Commission, be adjusted in the following manner: Each fee shall be  
5 multiplied by a fraction, the numerator of which is the Consumer Price Index for All Urban  
6 Consumers (base years 1982 – 1984 = 100) for the San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose area,  
7 published monthly by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics (the  
8 "Index"), for the quarter immediately preceding the start of the fiscal year during which the  
9 increase will be effective (the "Adjustment Index") minus the Index for the June ~~immediately of~~  
10 the preceding ~~the start of Year 1 year~~ (the "Base Index") and the denominator of which is the  
11 Base Index. The product of this calculation shall be added to the current fee to obtain the  
12 increased fee which shall thereafter be payable, except that in no instance shall the fee be  
13 less than that in effect immediately prior to this calculation. Or, fees may be increased up to  
14 \$1.00 upon approval of the Commission.

15 All fees and other charges at the Golf Courses may, but are not required to, be  
16 increased upon approval by the Commission at the same time and in the same manner as  
17 greens fees increases, except that the non-S.F. resident and tournament greens fees may be  
18 increased by up to two times the fraction produced in the above illustrated calculation (i.e., up  
19 to twice the increase in the applicable Consumer Price Index.), or up to \$1.00, whichever is  
20 greater.




