Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 203-06 (Annual Salary Ordinance FY 2006-2007) to reflect the addition of 1 positions (.125 FTE) in the Department of Public Health (DPH) – AIDS Office, and authorizing DPH to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$373,619 from the Department of Health and Human Services, National Institutes of Health and to approve three contracts with the following agencies: ISIS Inc., The University of Pittsburgh, and PHFE Management Solutions for the period of January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The hereinafter designated section and item of Ordinance No. 203-06 (Annual Salary Ordinance, FY 2006-2007) is hereby amended so that the same shall read as follows:

1 Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Contract Funds.

2 DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend grant funds from the
3 Department of Health and Human Services, National Institutes of Health (NIH) in the amount
4 of \$373,619, including \$40,319 in indirect costs. This grant will support the "Serosorting
5 among Men at Risk for HIV" project. DPH will subcontract with three agencies to fulfill the
6 goals and objectives of this project, including ISIS Inc., The University of Pittsburgh, and
7 PHFE Management Solutions. The period of this agreement is January 1, 2007 through
8 December 31, 2007. Subsequent years of funding are contingent upon approval.

9 DPH is further authorized to furnish whatever additional information or assurances the
10 funding agency may request in connection with this agreement, and execute any and all
11 agreements necessary to complete the transfer of funds.




