10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. Findings.

12 The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this  
13 Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public  
14 Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the  
15 Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_ and is incorporated herein by reference.

16 Section 2. The San Francisco Health Code is hereby amended by amending Section  
17 2017 to read as follows:

18 **SEC. 2017. FEE SCHEDULE.**

19 (a) All Applicants for a Certificate or a renewal of a Certificate shall submit an  
20 application fee of ~~one hundred and sixty three dollars (\$163)~~ \$178.

21 (b) In addition to the fee provided for in Subsection (a) of this Section, applicants who  
22 are not regulated under Article 21 of this Code shall pay an additional fee of ~~one hundred and~~  
23 ~~thirty dollars (\$130)~~ \$172.

24 (c) ~~Beginning with fiscal year 2008-2009, fees set forth in this Section may be adjusted each~~  
25 ~~year, without further action by the Board of Supervisors, as set forth in this Section.~~



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1 Not later than April 1 , the Director shall report to the Controller the revenues generated by the  
2 fees for the prior fiscal year and the prior fiscal year's costs of operation, as well as any other  
3 information that the Controller determines appropriate to the performance of the duties set forth in this  
4 Section.

5 Not later than May 15, the Controller shall determine whether the current fees have produced  
6 or are projected to produce revenues sufficient to support the costs of providing the services for which  
7 the fees are assessed and that the fees will not produce revenue which is significantly more than the  
8 costs of providing the services for which the fees are assessed.

9 The Controller shall, if necessary, adjust the fees upward or downward for the upcoming fiscal  
10 year as appropriate to ensure that the program recovers the costs of operation without producing  
11 revenue which is significantly more than such costs. The adjusted rates shall become operative on July  
12 1.


