3 **Ordinance amending San Francisco Transportation Code, Division I, by amending**
4 **Section 3.4 to change existing posting requirements for temporary parking restriction**
5 **signs for parades, public assemblies, film production, conflagrations, building**
6 **collapses and street obstructions and repairs.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. Division I of the San Francisco Transportation Code is hereby amended by
12 amending Section 3.4, to read as follows:

13 **Sec. 3.4. DIVERTING OF TRAFFIC AND TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS.**

14 (a) A Police Officer or Parking Control Officer may divert traffic from any street or
15 area, and/or may temporarily prohibit or restrict Parking on any street when made necessary
16 or advisable by any parade, public assemblage, ~~or~~ film production, traffic congestion,
17 conflagration, building collapse, obstruction on or damage to any street, residential move, or
18 the need to protect public health and safety.

19 (b) Except in the case of threats to public health or safety or emergency requiring
20 immediate response, any temporary Parking restriction or prohibition except those governed by
21 paragraph (c) of this Section shall be posted with appropriate signs displaying a contact person
22 and telephone number for information regarding the reasons for the restrictions. The contact
23 person shall be available to respond to inquiries during business hours. Such signs shall be
24 posted every 20 linear feet, and at each end of the zone in which Parking will be restricted or
25 prohibited, at least 72 hours in advance of the prohibition or restriction; provided, however,

1 that posting a notice of a temporary Parking restriction or prohibition at any Parking Space
2 with a meter, or by the Film Commission, may be posted no less than 24 hours in advance of
3 the prohibitions or restrictions.

4 (c) Except in the case of threats to public health or safety or emergency requiring immediate
5 response, any temporary Parking restriction or prohibition for any parade, public assemblage, film
6 production, traffic congestion, conflagration, building collapse, or obstruction on, or repair work to,
7 any street shall be posted with appropriate signs displaying a contact person and telephone number for
8 information regarding the reasons for the restrictions. The contact person shall be available to
9 respond to inquiries during business hours. Such signs shall be posted at least every 100 linear feet,
10 and at each end of the zone in which Parking will be restricted or prohibited, at least 72 hours in
11 advance of the prohibition or restriction; provided, however, that posting a notice of a temporary
12 Parking restriction or prohibition at any Parking Space with a meter, or by the Film Commission, may
13 be posted no less than 24 hours in advance of the prohibitions or restrictions. Parking limitations shall
14 apply for 100 linear feet on either side of each posted sign.


