

1 [Water Rates]

2 APPROVING REVISED SCHEDULE OF RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE SAN
3 FRANCISCO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION FOR WATER SERVICE TO ITS
4 SUBURBAN RESALE CUSTOMERS.

5 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

6 Section 1. The Public Utilities Commission adopted on April 27, 1999, its Resolution
7 No.99- 0110, after having held a public hearing on April 27, 1999 to consider a proposal for a
8 35% rate increase for water service and water supplied to its suburban resale customers with
9 long term contracts. Members of the public have been given an opportunity to express, and
10 have expressed their views on the recommended Schedule of Rates. Pursuant to a
11 published notice of intention of the Public Utilities Commission to adopt a revised Schedule of
12 Rates to be charged for suburban resale water service and a public hearing held on April 27,
13 1999, a copy of said Schedule W-25 Resale Use with Long Term Contract being on file in the
14 office of the Secretary of the Commission, the Commission recommended a 35% rate
15 increase as enumerated in the Schedule W-25 to be charged for suburban resale water
16 service.

17 Section 2. The foregoing rate schedule is for the purpose of meeting operating
18 expenses, including employee wage rate and fringe benefits, purchasing or leasing or
19 supplies, equipment or materials, meeting financial reserve needs and requirements,
20 obtaining funds for capital projects necessary to maintain service within existing service areas
21 and other budgetary requirements of the Public Utilities Commission's water service
22 enterprise.

23 Section 3. The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with Administrative Code
24 Sec. 2.25 - 2.29, recommended the revised Schedule of Rates to be charged for suburban
25 resale water service based upon the water service enterprise budget for the current and

1 ensuing fiscal year, and all the data supporting such conclusions. The Public Utilities
2 Commission has submitted to this Board in support of said Schedule the data upon which it is
3 based for the current fiscal year (1998-99) and the ensuing fiscal year (1999-2000).

4 Section 4. This Board of Supervisors hereby finds that said Schedule will provide
5 revenues adequate to fund the 1999-2000 departmental budget and will be sufficient to pay,
6 for the balance of the current year and for the ensuing fiscal year, expenses of every kind and
7 nature incidental to the operation and maintenance of the San Francisco water service
8 enterprise, together with the interest and sinking fund charges for any bonds issued for the
9 acquisition, construction or extension of the San Francisco water service enterprise, without
10 tax subsidy.


11 Section 5. The Certificate of Determination of Exemption/Exclusion From
12 Environmental Review on file in Board of Supervisors File No. 990924 states that
13 the adoption of the schedule, as stated herein, is exempt from environmental review
14 requirements in accordance with California Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(8).

15 Section 6. FY 1999-2000 Schedule W-25, as recommended by the Public Utilities
16 Commission and on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall be effective with
17 meter readings made on or after July 1, 1999.


