2 URGING THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO COMPLETE ITS
3 REVIEW OF THE REEVALUATION OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT OF THE
4 OCTAVIA BOULEVARD/CENTRAL FREEWAY REPLACEMENT PROJECT, TO FORWARD
5 ITS REVIEW TO THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION WITH A FAVORABLE
6 RECOMMENDATION, TO TRANSFER THE EMERGENCY RELIEF FUNDS DESIGNATED
7 FOR THE PROJECT TO THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, AND TO
8 DEVELOP A WORKPLAN WITH THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AS
9 QUICKLY AND EXPEDITIOUSLY AS POSSIBLE.

11 WHEREAS, Proposition E called for the City of San Francisco to authorize the
12 California Department of Transportation to replace the Central Freeway with an elevated
13 structure to Market Street and a ground-level boulevard from Market Street along Octavia
14 Street; and,

15 WHEREAS, On November 3, 1998, San Francisco voters approved Proposition E;
16 and,

17 WHEREAS, On November 4, 1999, San Francisco voters approved Proposition I,
18 reaffirming the City's preference for the Octavia Boulevard plan over reconstruction of the
19 Central Freeway; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
21 urges the California Department of Transportation to complete its review of the reevaluation
22 of the environmental assessment of the Octavia Boulevard project as quickly as possible and
23 that it forward its review to the Federal Highway Administration with a favorable
24 recommendation; and, be it

6 City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board urges the California Department of
8 Transportation to develop a workplan, including the construction timeline, traffic mitigation
9 plans, and design plans, in coordination with the City and County of San Francisco Central
10 Freeway Project Office as quickly and expeditiously as possible; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the
12 Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the California Department of Transportation
13 and the Federal Highway Administration with a request that they take all action necessary to
14 achieve the objectives of this resolution in order to close the Central Freeway and begin
15 demolition by September 1, 2000.




