11 display commonly used telephone numbers and contact information for various City
12 departments, City services and City programs; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That a pilot project be established within the Department of Public Works
14 to publicly display City related information for the benefit of San Francisco residents; and, be
15 it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Works identify fifty sites and/or
17 litter receptacles for the pilot project; and, be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Works report to the Board of
19 Supervisors within a calendar year on the status of the project and any related information.
