13 documentary film that seeks solutions for hate crimes; and,

14 WHEREAS, Judy Shepard recently visited San Francisco to appeal to Californians to
15 vote against Proposition 22, a state ballot initiative that would ban same-sex marriage; now,
16 therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
18 commends Judy Shepard for bringing her dignity, courage, and message of acceptance to


