4 WHEREAS, Aleph Zadik Aleph, or AZA, was formed in 1922 as an alternative to high  
5 school fraternities that excluded Jewish students; and,

6 WHEREAS, AZA became an official group in 1924 and was adopted as the B'nai B'rith  
7 Youth Organization ("BBYO") in 1925; and,

8 WHEREAS, BBYO is a worldwide organization which provides opportunities for Jewish  
9 youth to develop their leadership potential, a positive Jewish identity, and commitment to their  
10 personal development; and,

11 WHEREAS, BBYO has become one of the world's largest Jewish youth groups; and,

12 WHEREAS, Since 1925, more than 350,000 young men have passed through BBYO's  
13 ranks nationally; and,

14 WHEREAS, Over the past 75 years, AZA has emphasized friendships, empowerment,  
15 leadership, and fun for its members; and,

16 WHEREAS, AZA remains an organization for youth, started by youth, led by youth,  
17 and continuing to succeed at the hands of youth; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
19 commends Aleph Zadik Aleph upon its 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
